ACCREDITED COACH TRAINING PATHWAY

Those looking for an ICF credential can attend the five-day intensive and also participate in additional online learning, reading, peer group and tele-class activities.

Participants will have completed 60 hours of **coach specific training** required to apply for ICF Accreditation as an Associate Certified Coach (ACC level) [under the ACSTH pathway](#).

In addition to the 60 hours of training provided by GCI, participants seeking ICF ACC accreditation will need to complete:

- 100 hours of coaching sessions (75% paid hours)
- 10 hours of mentor coaching (minimum three individual and seven group mentoring)
- Online multiple choice Coach Knowledge questionnaire provided by ICF.

GCI offers individual mentor coaching sessions and group sessions for six participants. Check out our website for further details <http://globalcoachinginstitute.org/portfolio-item/mentoring-and-supervision/> or contact us directly if you would like to join a mentor coaching group. **Please note** that if you plan to complete the full GCI Coaching Foundations program (GCI101, 102 and 103) that 10 mentor coaching sessions are included in GCI 103.

Those wishing to complete the ICF **ACTP pathway** can enrol in **GCI 103 Coaching Untapped Potential**: <http://globalcoachinginstitute.org/portfolio-item/coaching-untapped-potential-gci-103/>. On completion of GCI 103 participants will have completed 129 hours of **coach specific training**, 10 hours of coach mentoring and will be eligible to apply for ICF Professional Certified Coach (PCC) under the PCC ACTP pathway.
