

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Personal Development

- 120 hours offsite seminars Facilitator Development (six 2.5 day seminars)
 - Community Transformation— work in the middle
 - Innerwork and peer supported practice
 - Support to burn your wood

- Individual work 120 hours 'training therapy' (60 hours transfer credit allowed from previous three years)





Masterclasses

- Focus on advanced practice and applications: faculty demonstration and modelling of advanced skills, indepth theory presentations, professional applications, and video study and case-control.
- Individual 65 hours over three quarters
 - Exams: Dream and Body Symptom; Altered States; In Depth Case
- Relationships 65 hours over three quarters
 - Exams: Relationship (couple), Own Relationship;
 Altered States; In Depth Case; Group
- Groups 65 hours over three quarters
 - Exams: Group, Relationship (couple), Own Relationship; Altered States, In Depth Case
- Integration and Professional Practice



Supervision

- 100 hours cohort based live supervision, over 5 training intensives
 - Triad live supervision classes (12 hours per quarter)
 - Community group processes (8 hours per quarter)
- Masterclass live and case supervision opportunities
- Individual supervision as needed from available 42 faculty hours

Individual Facilitation Masterclasses

- Advanced skills both for use in individual work contexts, and as they may come up in relationship and group work contexts.
- Extreme states; minimal consciousness in coma and palliative care contexts; spirituality and life purpose issues
- Sexuality and social marginalization, internalized oppression, long term and chronic processes, dreaming up and advanced practice in the use of the self
- Also, facilitating the individual in Group Process. At certain critical moments in a group process, an individual can become the leverage point for a group's transformation.



Relationship Facilitation Masterclasses

Advanced skills for use in working directly with couples, and as relationship processes may come up in individual and group work contexts.

Skills and metaskills for working with complex relationship situations including:

- family work, long term relationships, crisis and change in relationships, sexuality, addictions, complex family dynamics that include other social care or legal system agencies, custody issues, violence or substance use.
- Relationship facilitation within Group Process
- Advanced techniques for the use of the self as a source of information and facilitation interventions.



Group Facilitation Masterclasses

Advanced skills for use in working directly with small and large groups, and for addressing the way that group processes may impact or contextualize individual and relationship processes.

Working with complex group situations including:

- organizational change, organizational and team conflict;
- bullying, teamwork and leadership challenges;
- vision and mission development and transformation;
- working with and staying detached and useful during extreme or intractable types of conflict, such as personal attack, challenges to leadership, chaotic processes, and potential violence in facilitating intergroup or intercultural conflict in communities, organizations, and in the public space;
- understanding how trauma and extreme states of consciousness intersect with group difficulties;
- working with the aftermath of extreme and prolonged conflict, and with the complications of revenge following trauma and abuse.
